### The heroes

Crawl, Finn Walsh

- Out-of-control garage experiment
  - **Man o'War is escaping from his tank**
- Jennifer Edwards, friend from childhood
  - Health saved by his biotech, "the girl in the tank"
  - Student at UTSA, a bit radical
  - **Concerned about Finn's outlawry & issues**
- Liam, his brother, in the Air Force
  - Just got back into town
- His parents, usually out of town (he house-sits)
- Fellow bio-hackers – a questionable bunch, surely
  - **Figured out that the recent samples they're using are from live culture**
  - **Targeted by BAMC based on Ghost's tip**

The Oblate, Michael Solis

- Amanda Cabrera, Michael's girlfriend, pragmatic, gainfully-employed professional
  - **Old friends with Tina Long, knows she's in town**
  - Registered herself and Michael as married so he gets health insurance

Silverbeak, Brian Black

- Deceased grandfather, former superhero
- Robert Black, father
  - Expensive divorce proceedings
- Jennifer Power, ex-girlfriend
  - Student at UTSA, dating Matt
  - **Ready for some extremism – and to get Brian into it**

### Supporting cast, institutions, villains (or something)

University of Texas at San Antonio

- Campus Security, Brian's employer
  - Gardner, his supervisor
  - **Contracted with Xe following recent events; Ruiz targeting Antifa**
- Student activists
  - Matt, Jennifer Powers' boyfriend; would-be Antifa

Cody's Coffee

- Bob Fooden, manager, Finn's boss
- Fred (who?), ex-Monsanto – **headed for employment next to Finn**

Monsanto – pressuring both UTSA and the Blacks regarding Brian's powers, seeking full ownership

- Mr. Vorski, legal regarding the Black account
  - **Offers legal backstop for Brian re: API's suit**
- They must have some kind of GenTech hero on staff

American Policy Institute

- Based in Virginia; recent branch in Texas
- Spencer Richards, speaker at the rally
  - **Indicted via Silverbeak's report**
- Suing UTSA for infringement of all and sundry

Myrmidon

- Noldo Viera, CEO, disturbing philanthropist zillionaire
  - **Seeking to acquire the Lexicon Project in practice at least, in name if possible**

- Myrmidon(e): Tina Long
  - Posted to San Antonio for PR – shifts to UTSA to aid vs. API's suit
  - Contact for Father Ochoa; conveyed intel on Ghost's operation to him

#### Brooke Army Medical Center

- AmyBiota, power serum originator
  - Mobilizing to seek Crawl and the bio-hackers in general
- New power plant built in 2009
  - The original Man o'War is kept sedated in a tank with special power unit
  - He's deliquescing and destabilizing

#### The Lexicon Project

- Cheryl Macauley, prof at St. Mary College of Law
  - Overseeing grad program of the Lexicon Project, Michael's employer/mentor
  - Three upcoming students taught by Michael
- Dean John Weylunde, wants the Lexicon Project to get into high-profile humanitarianism
  - Identified as the leak to XE by Father Ochoa
  - Ghost's new target
- Father Manuel Ochoa, Oblate School of Theology
  - Overseeing occultist side of the Lexicon Project
  - Wants to get Michael into the Pastoral Ministry
  - Determined activist against immigration policy and ICE overstep,
  - Mind-scorched by Brimstone – event can be dataminced
  - OST chapel badly damaged in the fight with Ghost

#### Immigration Customs and Enforcement, San Antonio Field office

- U.S. Highway 281 North
  - Field Director: Clancy Graves
- PR and recruiting at UTSA
- Clandestine action vs. Father Ochoa's network
  - One sniff away from the Lexicon Project

#### Xe, formerly Blackwater

- outsourced collusion with ICE vs. the Lexicon Project's support of immigration rights
- Just outsourced for campus security at UTSA
  - Ruiz is the field officer
- Ghost
  - Director: Sonia Childe
  - Scorpion (Greg Perrin), Brimstone (Rod Ruiz), and Torment (Sandy Stafford)
  - Identified Crawl's super-serum powers; alerted BAMC
